Role Summary:

The Broadcast Technician - Cyprus, based Akrotiri, Cyprus will support all broadcast systems across Cyprus.

Reporting to the Technology Manager, Cyprus, they will be expected to support broadcast and IT systems to enable delivery of our TV, Radio, and Digital services and on occasion, they will support our Outside Broadcasts and Live Events.

The role is varied, with rarely two days the same, and will be a mixture of planned routine maintenance, compliance checks and installation at our radio studios, offices, transmitters item and cinemas, along with more reactive work to new requests or technical faults.

BFBS will support the successful applicant's knowledge growth through our training programme, and in house training and mentoring. Through this role the Broadcast Technician will develop experience in satellite communication, digital audio routine and digital mixing desks, audio playout systems, IT support, FM transmission systems, along with general building upkeep and infrastructure maintenance.

Your Main Responsibilities:

- To support all technological systems and workflows associated with the availability and delivery of BFBS production, broadcast and transmission services.
- To proactively identify opportunities to better meet the changing needs of our organisation and that of our customer.
- Identify improvements, efficiencies and changes required to any infrastructure, plant or systems.
- To create and maintain process and support documentation, ensuring that it is up to date, accessible and accurate.

- To establish & maintain relationships with colleagues at all levels across the organisation.
- To establish & maintain relationships with our customer, including local military command and officials either at, or representing our operational locations.
- To support BFBS management in delivering the organisational and department strategy as part of the Technology team.
- To champion written procedures and site documentation with a view to improving maintenance regimes and implementing best practice processes
- To improve and maintain the level of service we provide to our internal & external customers.
- To ensure that BFBS health & safety policy is adopted and followed, including the effective use of risk assessments.
- To be responsible for managing any other duties that are commensurate with this
 position or reasonably required.
